The German Academic Exchange Service (Deutscher Akademischer Austauschdienst) is a publicly-funded independent organization of higher education institutions in Germany, providing information from its 14 international offices as well as providing financial support to over 50,000 highly-qualified students and faculty per year for international research and study.

Eligibility Requirements are as follows:

- U.S. or Canadian citizenship or U.S. permanent resident and under 32 years of age at the start of the grant period
- Completed an undergraduate degree by the beginning date of the grant
- Enrolled in the nominating institution (i.e., Mount Holyoke may nominate only graduating seniors, not alumnae). Alumnae who have remained scholarly or scientifically active may direct apply (see DAAD web site).
- Proficiency in German appropriate to the plan of study (ordinarily a minimum of two years of college-level German) and a willingness to strengthen language skills prior to departure. Students in the natural and physical sciences may apply with little or no German background, but should plan to take German during the senior year.
