

GEORGE J. MITCHELL SCHOLARSHIPS



FOR STUDY IN IRELAND

APPLY AS A SENIOR OR ALUM!

The US-Ireland Alliance administers the George J. Mitchell Scholarships. The purpose of the award is to educate future American leaders about the island of Ireland - North and South - and to provide tomorrow's leaders with an understanding about, an interest in, and an affinity with, the island from which 38 million Americans claim descent. Scholars will be eligible to attend one of the institutions of higher learning in Ireland, including the seven universities in the Republic of Ireland and the two universities in Northern Ireland, for one academic year of post-graduate study beginning in the fall 2007.

Eligibility Requirements are as follows:

- U.S. citizenship at the time of application
- 18 or over but not yet thirty on October 1 in the year of application
- Academic standing sufficient to assure completion of a Bachelor's degree before they begin study under the Mitchell Scholarship
- Students in all fields of study and of all ethnic backgrounds are eligible to apply
