The Marshall Scholarships were established in 1953 to commemorate the humane ideals of the European Recovery Program (Marshall Plan). Marshall Scholars may study for a first or higher (i.e., undergraduate or graduate) degree in any discipline in any university in the United Kingdom for a period of at least two academic years. (Undergraduate work is more highly specialized in Britain than in the U.S., so pursuing a second bachelor's degree makes sense for some students, depending on their background.)

Eligibility Requirements are as follows:

- U.S. Citizenship
- Completed U.S. undergraduate degree after April 2004, regardless of your age
- Minimum grade point average of 3.7
