



### **Susan Jones Prize in Women's Studies**

Prizes awarded annually for outstanding essays on a topic in Women's Studies and for exemplary feminist activism. One prize to be given each year in each of the following categories:

- (1) best essay or independent project by a senior Women's Studies major (submitted for 390; or another 300-level course);
- (2) best essay by a student (first-year, sophomore, or junior; not necessarily a Women's Studies major or minor) in a women's studies class (any women's studies core course or cross-listed course);
- (3) a Women's Studies major or minor who has demonstrated extraordinary commitment to social justice either within or outside the College community.

Nominations to come from student herself, other students, faculty, community activist, or community agency. A cash prize will be awarded.

Prizes will be awarded during the Gender Studies "At-Home" on Commencement Weekend 2010.

Deadline for the review of applications is FRIDAY, MAY 7, 2010, but ongoing application submissions are encouraged.
