Re: A Check-list for Graduation Requirements in Gender Studies AY 2007-08

As you plan and carry out your major in Gender Studies, you may find this form useful in gaining a broader perspective on your program of study and in giving that program coherent shape and clear direction. You may also find it helpful in keeping track of requirements that you have satisfied, and those that remain to be fulfilled. It may make advising conferences more efficient and useful. **It may also save you time when, in the first semester of your senior year, you are asked to submit a completed check-list, with a description of your concentration, to the Department Chair via Cindy Meehan in 109 Shattuck Hall.**

When identifying the course for each requirement below, be sure to record where you took it, if not at Mount Holyoke. **PLEASE INDICATE COURSE NUMBER AND COMPLETE COURSE TITLE, INSTRUCTOR'S NAME and SEMESTER and YEAR TAKEN.**

*Note that this check-list is limited to Gender Studies Major requirements; it does **not** include other College requirements for graduation.*

A minimum of 40 credits (of which 20 credits must be at the 300 level) are required for the major in Gender Studies and must include Gender Studies 101, Introduction to Gender Studies; 201, Feminist Methods; 221, Feminist Theory; 250, Gender and Power in Global Contexts; 333, Interdisciplinary Seminar (2 courses under this rubric); 390, Internship or Field Project; and the 391-392 Senior Seminar.
