Kanae Haneishi is the head soccer coach at Mount Holyoke College. She served as a Head Coach of Western United FC 17-18 Girls in 2005-07 and won the MA state final four. She also served as Assistant Coach at Smith College (2005-07) as well as University of Memphis (2003-05). She won a Silver Medal with the Japanese National Team in World University Games in 2003, won NCAA Division II National Championship and Outstanding defensive player of the National Tournament in 2002. She currently plays for a semi-pro team in NYC, New York Magic, as a captain and has worked various soccer camps and clinic nationally and internationally.
