**SELF-SCHEDULED EXAMINATIONS** - Students must present I.D. cards at the center. Students who have lost their I.D. cards may obtain a replacement ID card for \$20.00 by going to the One-Card office located on the ground floor of the Central Services Building.

Students should enter Hooker at the upper level by the doors nearest the Amphitheater. Then follow signs to the appropriate exam distribution areas. Exams are to be taken in the designated classrooms. Open-book rooms will be posted. **Examinations are two hours in length with an extra half-hour permitted.**
