 - 4:15-5:30 any day
 - 6-7:30 on Tuesdays and Thursdays only.
- A few sections of science labs in courses where there are many lab choices may be scheduled in the evenings any day 7-10pm.

Classes must not be scheduled during Faculty Meeting hours, Wednesday from 4:10-6:00 pm. All classes, with the exception of 4-hour labs and classes in the 3:15-5:05 Monday seminar slot, must end at 4:05 pm to allow student participation in music, athletic, and extracurricular activities. All requests for deviations must be appealed to the Academic Policy Committee's subcommittee for course review and approval. Requests for deviations must be submitted to the Registrar, who is a member of the subcommittee, at the time the preliminary schedule information is submitted.
