SELF-SCHEDULED EXAMINATIONS - Students must present I.D. cards at the exam center, Hooker Auditorium. If you have lost your I.D. card, obtain a replacement for \$25.00 by going to the One-Card office located on the ground floor of the Central Services Building.

Students should enter Hooker at the upper level by the doors nearest the Amphitheater. Then follow signs to the appropriate exam distribution areas. All exams must be taken in a designated exam classroom; some are marked as appropriate for open-book exams. **Examinations are two hours in length, with an extra half-hour permitted.**

Physically-challenged students requiring assistance obtaining their examinations from Hooker may contact Mary Fitzmeyer in the Registrar's Office ext. 2025, so that arrangements can be made prior to the beginning of the Examination Period.

Students who choose to start an examination late during one of the examination sessions must return the examination by the end of that session, thereby shortening the available time for taking the examination.
