Quality points are determined by taking the numeric equivalent of the grade you earned and multiplying that by the number of credits you earned. So, an A in a four-credit course earns you 16 quality points, since the numeric equivalent for an A is 4.00, an A- is 3.67, a B+ 3.33, a B 3.0 etc. When calculating a GPA, the quality points are divided by the number of credits attempted in graded courses not exempted from inclusion in the GPA.

## 2) Unofficial Transcript

Select this option to see a complete listing of courses you have or are registered for and the grades already earned in those courses. Your unofficial transcript also shows any honors that you have earned while studying at Mount Holyoke that have been published in the Commencement Program.
