

## APPLICATION FOR 2009 SUMMER HOUSING MOUNT HOLYOKE COLLEGE

A limited number of residence hall rooms will be available in Dickinson House and Pearsons Annex to current Mount Holyoke students for rent during the summer. **Please complete this form and return it to the Office of Residential Life, 1 Safford Hall, by 4 p.m. May 1<sup>st</sup>.** Notification will be emailed to you on May 11<sup>th</sup>. Any applications received after May 1<sup>st</sup> will be placed based on available space. Residential Life will not accept any request for Summer Housing after August 15, 2009.

### GUIDELINES FOR SUMMER HOUSING

- Housing is available from Friday, May 15<sup>th</sup> through the start of school in September.
- Students are responsible for transporting their own belongs to and from their summer housing residence.
- Preference will be given to students who will remain on campus for more than four (4) weeks and who are employed by or conducting research with the College.
- In order to be eligible for housing students must clear all of their financial obligations with the College **through the Student Financial Services Office** and clear any other holds in place by Health Center, Counseling Services or Residential Life.
- Graduating seniors, students recently withdrawn from the College or students currently on or planning on taking a fall non-academic leave are not eligible for summer housing.
- Rent is charged monthly. Rent will be billed to the student's account. Rent is charged by room type. The rental fee structure will be \$400.00 for per month, \$100.00 per week or \$15.00 per day for a single room assignment. The monthly charge is discounted to \$300.00 per month, \$100.00 per week and \$15.00 per day for a double room assignment.
- There are a limited number of singles and doubles available. If the number of requests for a specific type of room exceeds the number of rooms available, student assignments will be made by lottery. Students who are not assigned in choice of room type will be housed in the spaces available and charged the corresponding rate.
- Rent will be charged from the date in which you check in to the date in which you check out **AND** return your room key, regardless if you use the room or not.
- There are limited services on campus, no campus meals, transportation etc. The Health Center and Counseling Services are closed for the summer. Students with health or mental health concerns will be sent to area hospitals via ambulance.
- All campus community standards outlined in the Student Handbook and Residential Life policies apply. The Student Handbook is available online on the Dean of Students webpage. Residential Life policy is found in the Policies section of the Residential Life webpage.
- Long-term guests are not permitted in the residence halls. Residents cannot sublet their room.
- A student whose behavior is offensive, inappropriate, or cause a concern of safety for themselves or others will be removed from summer housing immediately.
