 - Planning and leading the residence staff orientation and training (6/21-27)
 - Directing and supervising the undergraduate residence staff
 - Designing and implementing the residence programming
- Working closely with the program directors, including work prior to staff week

Qualifications/Duties as Assistant Head Resident:

- Position open to rising college juniors and beyond
- Sharing supervisory and administrative duties with the Head Resident
- Participating in staff week and assisting with the residence staff orientation and training (6/21-27)
- Participating in the planning and implementation of programming
