- Students applying to **Dartmouth** must also apply directly to the Thayer School of Engineering, by February 1 of the sophomore year. The 2-1-1-1 schedule is standard, but admission may be deferred to permit a 3-2 schedule (although this is not guaranteed).
- Students applying to Caltech must also apply directly to Caltech by April 1 of the junior year.
- Students applying to **Dartmouth or Caltech** must also complete an application for academic leave by March 1 of the year before their first year away.
