

Mick Caouette is an acclaimed documentary filmmaker who began his career in 1996, as an Associate Producer for two *Court TV* films, *The Scottsboro Boys* and *The Capture and Trial of Adolph Eichmann*. He later produced *Restore America with Bob Villa* on HGTV.

Since 1999, Mick has produced four independent films, including *Hubert H Humphrey: The Art of the Possible* and *Mr Civil Rights: Thurgood Marshall and the NAACP* – both of which are currently appearing nationally on PBS.

Mick's current film, a biography of Labor Secretary Frances Perkins, entitled *Summoned: Frances Perkins and the General Welfare*, is scheduled to be released to public television stations nationwide on March 1st 2020.
