



Directions to Mount Holyoke College

By Car *From the south:* North on I-91 to Route 202 (Exit 16, Holyoke/South Hadley). North on 202 through Holyoke, across the Connecticut River, and around the rotary to the South Hadley Center-Amherst exit; Route 116 north for 2.5 miles. *From the north:* South on I-91 to Exit 16; follow directions above. *From the Mass Turnpike, east or west:* Exit 5 (Holyoke/Chicopee) to Route 33 for five miles; right onto 116; 1.5 miles north to MHC.
