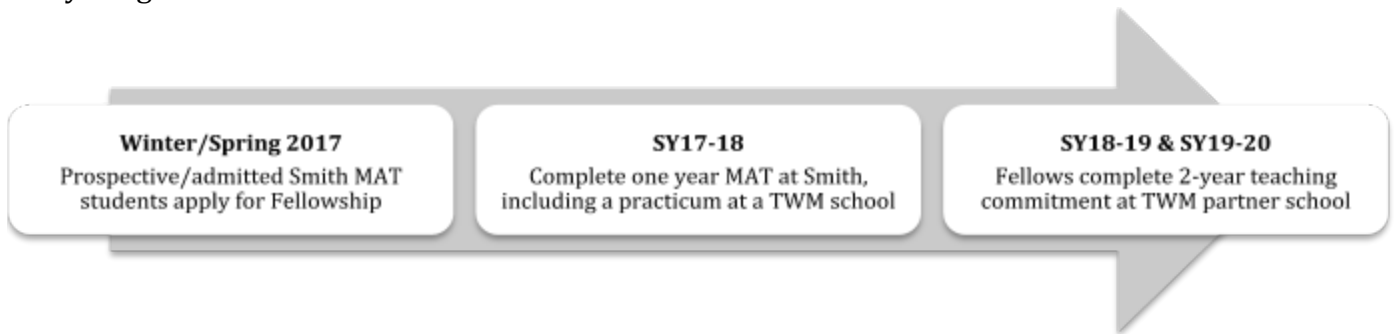


The Smith/Mount Holyoke-Teach Western Mass Fellowship

Fellowship: *The Smith & Mount Holyoke -Teach Western Mass Fellowship* is an applicant-based fellowship and stipend for students enrolled in either Smith College or Mount Holyoke College's one year Master of Arts in Teaching degree program. Students enrolled in the Fellowship Program will graduate from Smith or Mount Holyoke and enter a two-year full-time teaching commitment with one of twenty-seven [Teach Western Mass partner schools](#). In addition to a \$9,999 living stipend, Fellows will have unique development opportunities through one-on-one mentorship, monthly professional development sessions, and continued access to the resources of Smith Education & Child Study Program and MHC.



Program Requirements: Fellows will learn of their acceptance to the program before beginning Smith/MHC's MAT degree program. In order to receive the stipend, Fellows are required to:

- Be accepted into and complete the Smith or MHC MAT program
- Complete both Fall and Spring practicum at a Teach Western Mass partner school
- Participate in professional development and mentorship opportunities
- Upon graduation, complete a two-year, full-time, salaried teaching commitment at a Teach Western Mass partner school

Who Can Apply? The Smith & Mt. Holyoke -Teach Western Mass Fellowship is open to all students who plan on enrolling in the Smith College or MHC Master of Arts in Teaching degree program. Of the Smith applicants, preference will be given to students who plan to participate in the *Smith College Project Coach Fellowship*.

Application Timelines: Prospective and accepted students can apply to the Fellowship Program on a rolling basis. Students considering acceptance to the fellowship as a factor in enrollment decisions are encouraged to apply early.

- **Round One:** January 15th
- **Round Two:** February 13th
- **Round Three (Final Deadline space allowing):** June 1st
